ARTIST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Manager: **DUDEE YELLOW**

AN AGREEMENT made this **TWELFTH** day of **JULY** 1984

BETWEEN **TOM GARDNER** (hereinafter called "The Artist") of the one part
of **DUNDEE REPERTORY THEATRE**

AND **KERR GARDINER** (hereinafter called "The Artist") of the other part,
of **7 BELVEDERE CRESCENT, BISHOPBRIGGS, GLASGOW**

All provisions of the Regulations set out in Schedules 1 and 2 hereinafter called "The Regulations" shall apply to this engagement, and shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Agreement.

A COPY OF THE REGULATIONS SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON THE NOTICE BOARD IN EACH THEATRE

1. The Manager hereby engages the Artist to perform the duties of ...

2. The engagement shall commence on the **THIRTEENTH** day of **AUGUST**, 1984, and shall extend for an indefinite period commencing on the date of the first performance of a production in which the Artist is engaged on the date on which such notice is given to the Artist.

3. The Manager shall pay the Artist the sum of **£ 95,000** per week (inclusive of subsistence) through the hands of the parties on the day and year first above written.

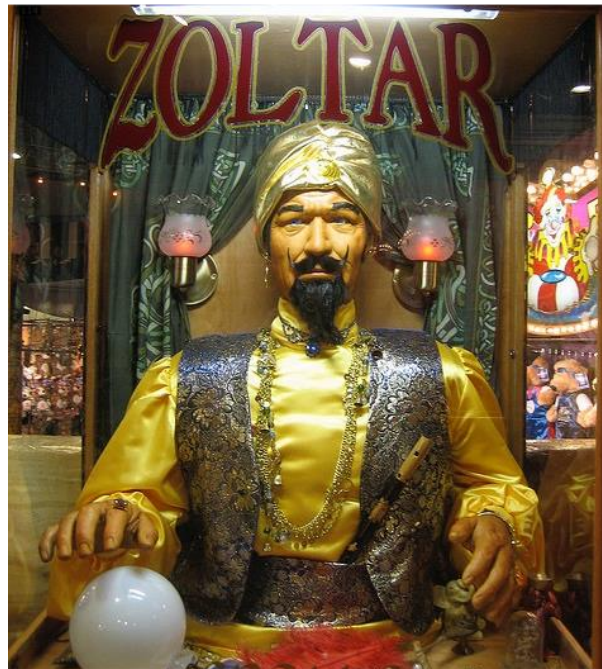
A second for-profit institution has been granted the title of university.
